Parade Procedure:

In accordance with Article 25 of the GTWCE Sporting Regulations, the Stewards inform of the following Parade Rules and Instructions:

PARADE INSTRUCTIONS AND PROCEDURE:

The parade activation is an important moment for all the fans, the event and all the teams. Please ensure you read the following instructions and abide by the rules.

Each GT World Team must be listening to the race control radio and be ready to release the cars. The below parade timetable is approximate but must be followed. Any updated versions will be distributed and communicated closer to the event.

FOR ALL DRIVERS:

A large number of spectators are anticipated along the entirety of the route. As such, safety is of the highest priority. Drivers should pay close attention at all times.

There is to be strictly no overtaking, and cars must maintain a constant speed of up to 70km/h without slowing down and accelerating. Burn, stop and go, waving, are not permitted and will be penalized.

There will be Officials and Police along the parade route, making note of any cars not abiding by the parade rules. This is for your safety, the public safety and to continue this activation for years to come.

RACE CAR PARADE RULES

- Drivers must always drive their cars. No mechanics.
- Race suits are not mandatory.
- ALL cars must be in conformity with the Graphical Charter and its Appendix 1
- There are NO passengers allowed in race cars entered for the event.
- Team assistance vehicles are not permitted to join the parade
- No quads in the parade
- No scooters in the parade
- All cars must have Lights On
- All cars must drive and act RESPONSIBLY and SAFELY
- Any cars not attending the parade will be in parc fermé conditions inside their garages at the circuit. Marshalls will stay with the car.
- Any cars stopping on the parade route will be in parc fermé.
- Parc fermé will be opened on the team messaging app after the parade.

Note: the organiser will provide fire trucks and tow trucks in case of any issues. It is not allowed to use quad or organize any other vehicle to tow the cars back to the circuit.

The parade is mandatory for GT World Challenge Europe & GT4 European cars. It is optional for all other series.



ENTRY TO THE CIRCUIT TO LA SOURCE (times are approximate):

Accredited Cars arrive at *PARKING P2* at 16:00

- Accredited cars (VIP, Shuttles, Manufacturer cars, Supercars, Police, Army and Sponsor cars)

Depart from Parking P2 at 16:50

- Accredited cars

GT World Cars - Depart from Pit Exit from 17:05 called in brand order

- GT World Race Cars

Cars arrive at Eau Rouge gate from;

- 17:15 - GT4 European Series
- 17:25 McLaren Trophy Europe
- 17:35 GT3 Legends

Depart from Eau Rouge gate from 17:45

- GT4 European Series
- McLaren Trophy Europe
- GT3 Legends

All cars leave for the Parade from 18:00

EXIT FROM THE CIRCUIT TO SPA CITY CENTRE:

- All cars must exit at a moderate speed (not exceeding **70kph**).
- Only racing cars and accompanying cars with specific **parade-numbered stickers** will be allowed to take part.

All other cars will need to go to Spa by their own means, outside of the convoy. Mandatory itinerary:

- Highway E42 to Spa, exit 8 – Tiège/Spa
- Take the N629 to Spa
- When you arrive at Radisson Blue Balmoral, take the first exit at the roundabout on Avenue Leopold II, then Avenue des Platanes

Park at the train station parking – highlighted on the map as PARKING TEAMS.

TEAM PARKING

Each Team will get ONE team parking pass (every three cars entered at the event) for the city centre. The Team Parking will be located at the Spa Train Station, closer to the venue, with a better access to exit the parade to go back to the circuit.



ORDER OF THE PARADE WHEN LEAVING THE CIRCUIT

Note that all the cars taking part in the parade will be divided into groups per Manufacturer or Series. There will be a Police escort in front and behind each group, this is to control the speed, the burn outs, and have more security.

Accredited cars will be put in order in Parking P2 before gaining access to the track.

ORDER OF GT3 CARS & MANUFACTURERS

This is the order that the GT3 cars will be called out of pitlane. Please listen to the Race Control Radio and leave when you are called;

- Porsche
- Mercedes-AMG
- BMW
- Ferrari
- Ford
- Corvette
- McLaren
- Lamborghini
- Audi
- Aston Martin

GT4 European Series, McLaren Trophy and GT3 Legends will be released from Eau Rouge gate.

SPA TOWN

Following the arrival in Spa town center, please **follow the instructions of the SRO team** on-site. They will direct race cars to their parking spaces. Please park as quickly as possible.

All GT World drivers - once they have arrived at the city centre must go to the autograph session **in front of the Stage / Galerie Leopold** according to the dedicated timetable for each car.

Drivers are advised to wear Team Kit.

Briefing schedule:

19:45: Sign On at Le Petit Theatre in the Casino de Spa

20:00: CrowdStrike 24 hours of Spa / GT World BRIEFING

At 20:45 everyone should head back to their cars and await instructions from the SRO team to depart Spa.

Support Series please see the timetable for any activities, autograph sessions or briefings taking place and organized by your Series once you arrive in the town.

ACCREDITED CARS / MANUFACTURER CARS / SHUTTLES / OFFICIAL CARS / VIP CARS PARADE RULES

Accredited cars must be in Parking P2 (Near the Ster entrance) with their cars at 16:00.
We will put you all in order in Parking P2.

At 16:50, we will leave for the gate to the circuit following the SRO car. **You will turn right to go the wrong way up the track to get into position.** Cars are **NOT** authorised to do a lap of the track.
Follow SRO instructions.

All cars must:

- Switch their headlights and hazard lights on
- If Official cars are equipped with roof lights, switch it on for the duration of the parade

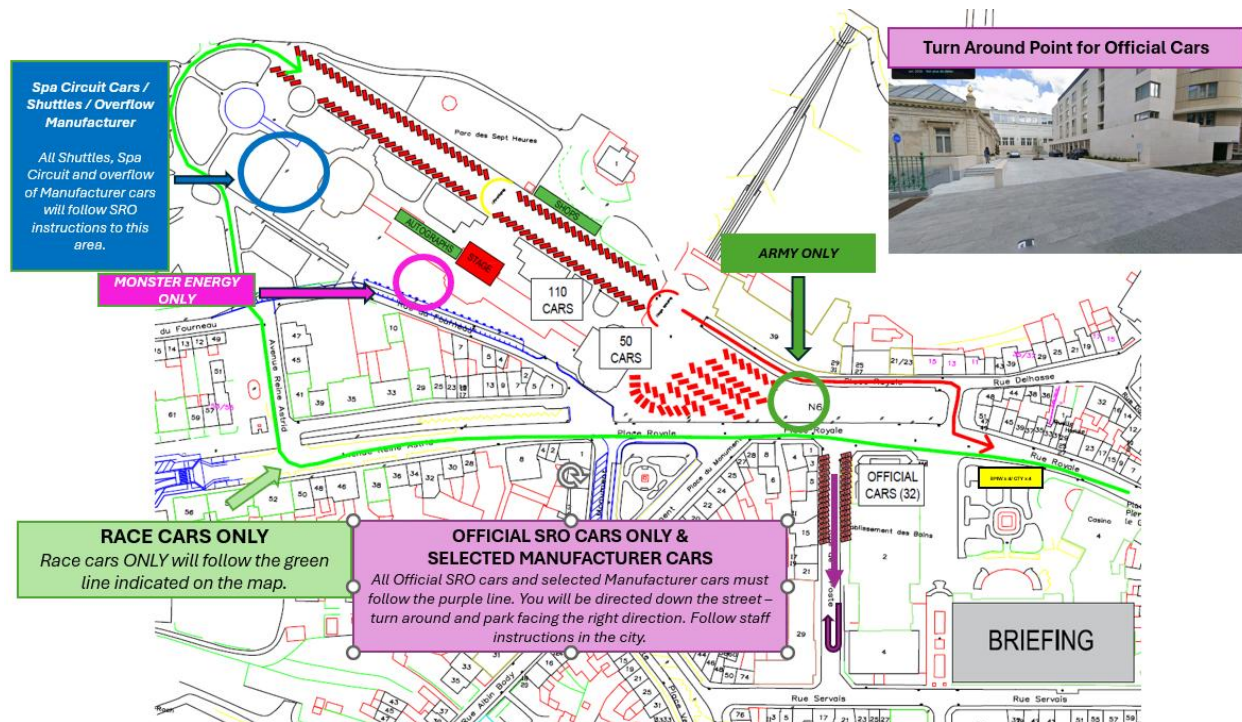
Cars will be lined up in order of the above GT3 Manufacturer groups. SRO will put you in the correct order in Parking P2. Cars will be released in order at the back of their GT3 cars on to the track.

Any cars that miss their slot will be placed at the back of the parade. Accredited cars must be ready to join the parade, only once called by SRO personnel.

Follow the rhythm of the cars in front of you. Don't slow down and accelerate suddenly to please the spectators.

ACCREDITED CARS CITY PARKING

Please follow SRO instructions. SRO Official cars will follow the purple line. Selected Manufacturer cars will follow the purple line. All other cars will go to the blue parking area indicated on the map.



ALL CARS PARADE RETURN

Due to the time, visibility will be decreasing during the return journey. There will still be public along the roads, so once again please pay very close attention and maintain a moderate speed and FOLLOW the instruction listed above. LIGHTS ON!!! Thank you for your cooperation.

In 2026, cars will be released in small groups, back to the circuit – this is to help with the congestion. Please be patient and follow the instructions of SRO staff and Officials.

REMINDER FOR ALL DRIVERS:

There will be more spectators on the way back to the circuit and along the entirety of the route. As such, safety is of the highest priority. Drivers should pay close attention at all times.

There is to be strictly no overtaking, and cars must maintain a constant speed of up to 70km/h without slowing down and accelerating. Burn, stop and go, waving, etc, are not permitted and will be penalized.

There will be Officials along the parade route, making note of any cars not abiding by the parade rules. This is for your safety, the public safety and to continue this activation for years to come.

MEDIA & TV

Photographers and videographers from teams and manufacturers must respect security instructions from the Police and SRO staff and stay on the pavement and cannot be lying on the ground or standing on the roads when the cars are arriving. Media credentials will be removed for the event for anyone not respecting instructions given by police or SRO staff.

Absolutely NO drones except for SRO in the city centre.

DRIVER REGISTRATION


