STEWARDS' DECISION

To: Car Collection Motorsport

The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, summoned and heard from the competitor's representative, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No. / Driver: 8 - Joel STURM

Competitor: Car Collection Motorsport

Time: 16:30

Session: Free Practice 2

Fact: Caused a collision with car 28 at T9

Offence: Breach of Article 27.4 of the GT World Challenge Europe powered by AWS 2026 Sporting Regulations and Article 12.2.1.j of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter IV Article 2d) of Appendix L to the Code

Decision: Drop of 10 places on the grid next race + 1 BWP

Reason: The Stewards examined video evidence. They summoned and heard from the team representative of Car 8. Car 8 (Sturm-Gold Driver) attempted an inside pass on Car 28 (Castelein-Bronze Driver) at the entry of turn 9, which resulted in a collision between the two cars. Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that Car 8 was wholly to blame for the incident, therefore they decide to apply the standard 10 place grid drop for the next race and 1 behaviour warning point.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
